Accompaniment 3/4 Rhythm | = Strum Downwards ADE = Chords

Notes

'Bar Lines' separate the groups of 3 strums. The 1st beat (strum) in each bar is the heavy one.

Length of Strums – don't try to hit all the strings on every strum. Perhaps you can start by hitting 5 or 6

strings on the heavy strum, and 3 or 4 strings on the others. Don't hit the guitar too hard!

Sing 'A' of Amazing first, and then begin strumming on 'ma'.
